

### **CHARGING THE BATTERY**

Insert the included charging cable into the charging port on the vacuum cleaner.

Connect the USB end of the charging cable to an appropriate adapter and then into a wall outlet.

Charge the vacuum completely for about 3.5 hours prior to first use.

"When the charging LED indicator is red, the vacuum is charging. When it turns blue, charging is complete.

## **USING THE VACUUM**

Unplug the machine from the charging adapter.

Ensure filter is installed correctly and there are no obstructions at the opening of the vacuum.


Press the power button to turn ON.

## USING THE BRUSH ATTACHMENT

Make sure the vacuum is turned OFF.

Secure the included brush attachment to the nozzle of the hand vacuum.

Once securely attached, turn the vacuum ON.



### **EMPTYING THE DIRT BIN**

Twist the dirt bin to remove from the base.



Remove the filter by pulling up from the dirt bin. Empty the dirt into a waste container.



When finished emptying the dirt, reassemble the vacuum.

After heavy use, clean the filter and dirt bin by washing gently by hand in warm water and mild dish detergent. Rinse thoroughly and make certain it is completely dry before reinserting it.
