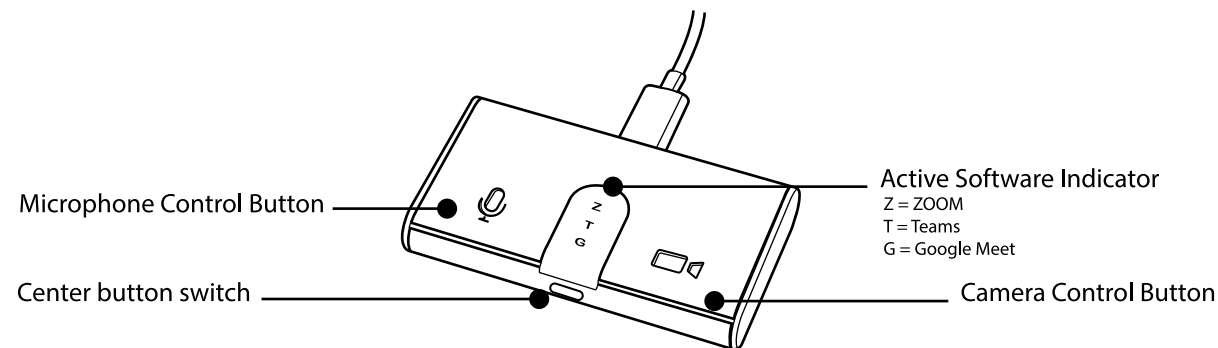

Getting Started:

Connect the included USB-C cable to the USB-C port of the Hush Buddy Mute Button. Connect the other end of the cable to your computer. When the connection is successful, the Hush Buddy is ready to work during video calls. The Hush Buddy automatically recognizes whether the current connection is to a Windows or Mac operating system and automatically issues the corresponding shortcut key functions. When the Hush Buddy is connected to an Apple computer for the first time, macOS will display the keyboard setup screen, please refer to the section "Not for macOS" to complete the setup. The Hush Buddy is now ready to be used. Open either ZOOM, Microsoft Teams, or Google Meet on your computer. Press the center button switch to toggle between your active video call applications. Use the two control buttons to turn on/off the microphone or turn the camera on/off. When the Hush Buddy is not in use, it is recommended to unplug it from the computer to prevent the shortcut keys from affecting other software when either button is pressed by mistake.



Notes for macOS:

When the Hush Buddy is plugged into an Apple computer for the first time, macOS will detect the new USB device and a keyboard setup screen will appear. Because the Hush Buddy is designed as a compact keyboard device, you must complete setup before use on a mac OS.

Please follow the "macOS setup" to successfully set up the Hush Buddy on macOS.

macOS Setup:

When the keyboard assistant screen appears, select "continue" to proceed to the next step. Next, the "Identifying your keyboard" screen will appear, press the Z button on your keyboard. When the prompt "Your keyboard cannot be identified" appears, click the skip button to proceed to manual setup. Select the type of keyboard manually, please select the standard 101-key keyboard and click done to finish the setup.

If the Hush Buddy is not correctly identified by the above steps, it can be identified by the following manual setup procedure:

Go to System Preferences, select the keyboard option and click enter. Select "Change keyboard type". When the keyboard setup assistant appears, select "Continue" and then press "First Connection Setup". Then proceed with normal keyboard setup.

Caution:

Third party software may interfere with the Hush Buddy when it is running continuously in the background. It is recommended that you temporarily close the third party software that produces interferences while using the Hush Buddy for video calls. When the video meeting software is running in a non-maximized window, once the focus of the program is shifted by other software, the effect generated by the key will be shifted to the other software, and will not have effect on the video meeting software. When the video software is closed, do not press the Hush Buddy buttons, the shortcut code issued by the Hush Buddy may inadvertently effect other third party software, it is recommended to unplug the Hush Buddy after video meetings to avoid unintended use of the device.

Safety:

Do not drop, apply excessive force, or puncture the device.
Do not attempt to repair, disassemble, or modify any component of this product in any way.
Keep the device away from any extreme temperature or humidity.
Power this product only with the power cable provided.
Keep the product and power cable away from small children.
